




I'm a little teapot short and stout. Here is my handle, here is my spout. When I get all steamed up hear me shout, Tip me over and pour me out!




Baa baa black sheep have you any wool?

Yes sir, yes sir, three bags full.






Hey diddle diddle, the Cat and the fiddle, The cow jumped over the moon. The little dog laughed to see such sport, And the dish ran away with the spoon.

Eden – Mary Had a Little Lamb





<u>Micha – Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star</u>







London Bridge is falling down, My fair lady! Take the key and lock her up, And lock her up. And lock her up. Take the key and lock her up, My fair lady!




Little Bo Peep has lost her sheep And Can't tell where to find them. Leave them alone and they'll come home Wagging their tails behind them.


Caleb – One, Two Buckle My Shoe






One, two buckle my shoe; Three, four shut the door; Five, six pickup sticks; Seven, eight lay them straight; Nine, ten big fat hen.






Jack and Jill Went up the hill To fetch a pail of water. Jack fell down And broke his crown And Jill came tumbling after.

Jenna – Little Miss Muffet




Little Miss Muffet Sat on her tuffet Eating her Curds and whey; Along Came a spider Who sat down beside her And frightened Miss Muffet away.
